G-191 ICS/EOC INTERFACE (ICSEOC) • Oct. 19

The ICS/EOC Interface Workshop (G191) is designed to provide participants the ability to develop ICS/EOC interface implementation strategies or action plans for their communities. By proposing and discussing options in a neutral environment, and to help them understand that there are no rigid solutions to the ICS/EOC interface issues.

This eight hour course will enable the participants to develop an effective interface between the Incident Command and the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) by applying Incident Command System (ICS) principles.

G-386 MASS FATALITIES INCIDENT RESPONSE (MFIR) • Oct. 20-21

The Mass Fatalities Incident Response Course (G386) is designed to provide participants with a basic understanding of how to plan for, response to, and recover from a mass fatalities incident.
